TJCL CONVENTION A SUCCESS

The 1983 Tennessee Junior Classical League Convention was held on April 22-23 at Briarcrest Baptist High School and Memphis University School in Memphis. There were 872 students and 43 sponsors from 41 schools attending the convention.

With Shawn Snipes, vice-president, presiding in place of Dawn Blair, who was absent due to illness, the general assembly was held at the Briarcrest auditorium. The assembly consisted of reports from various TJCL officers and an orientation of the day's activities.

During the morning, delegates set off to the Olympic or Certamen events held at Memphis University School. Swimming events were held at the Jewish Community Center.

The results of the very competitive Certamen tournaments were known by 12 o'clock with Franklin Road Academy winning the lower division and Northeast High School winning the upper division. These two teams will represent Tennessee this summer at the national convention.

During the evening the skit contest and dance took place along with the judging of English oratory and Latin Interpretation. The dance, which featured a live band, gave everyone the chance to meet people and have some fun after a day of hard work. During this time, many of the candidates for the next year's TJCL officers began their campaigns.

On Saturday morning, the Olympic, Certamen, and Arts results were announced, and the best oratory and costumes were presented. Harpeth Hall won the Olympics Sweepstakes with MUS placing second, and Hutchison placing third. Northeast won the Academic Sweepstakes with Harpeth Hall placing second, and Bearden placing third. Sullivan East, Sevier County, and Clarksville Academy won first-place Overall Sweepstakes awards in their divisions. For placing first in 4th year Pentathlon, Andrew Riggsby received a full scholarship, generously donated by Mat Lipscomb, to attend the National Convention in Rochester. Then following the installation of the newly-elected officers, the 1983 TJCL Convention was adjourned by the new president, Brenda Timms.

The TJCL would like to thank Mr. Carmack, Mrs. Higgs, and Mr. Tackett for helping the convention be a success.

I would like to congratulate all the winners for their achievements and I hope to see many of you at the National Convention this summer. We need to maintain our excellence and keep our state in the number one position.

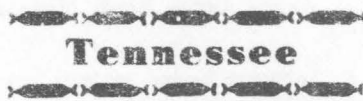

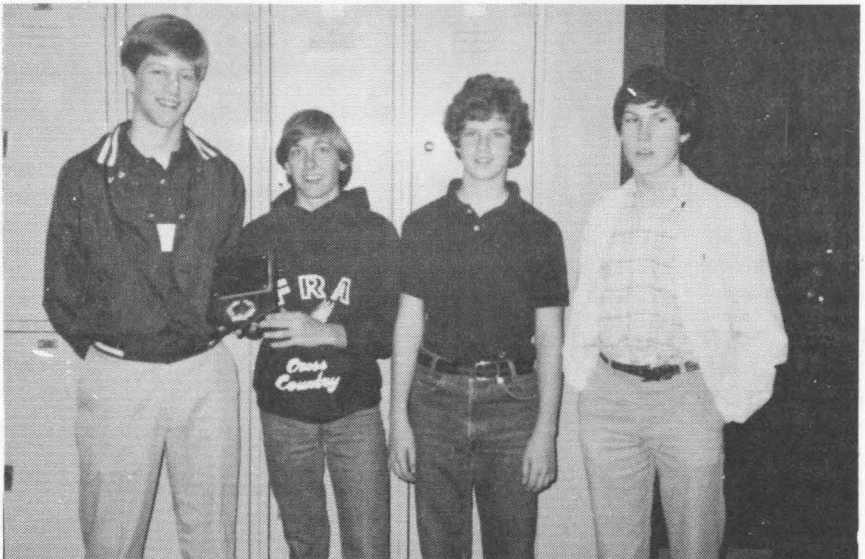

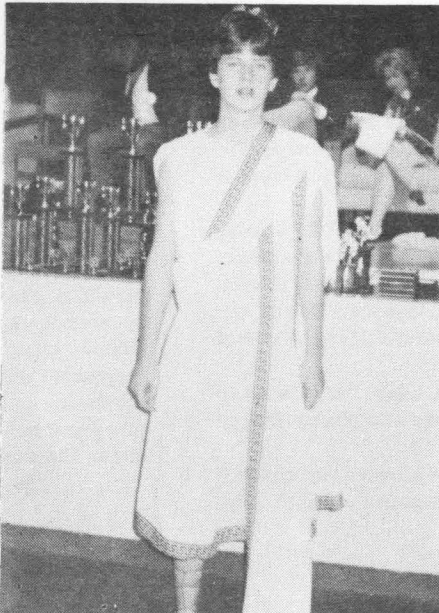
