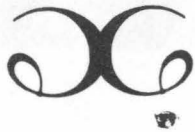
Salvete, TJCL'ers!

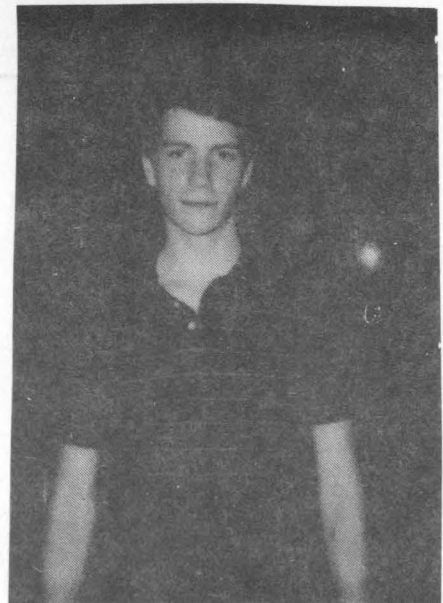
Classical Tennesseans,

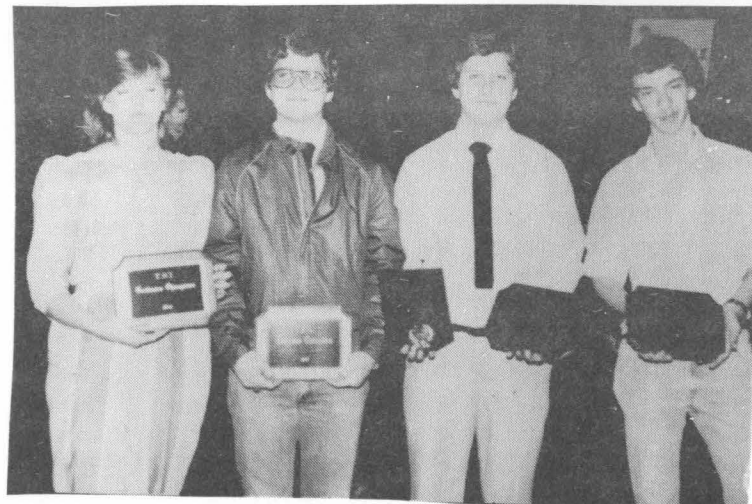

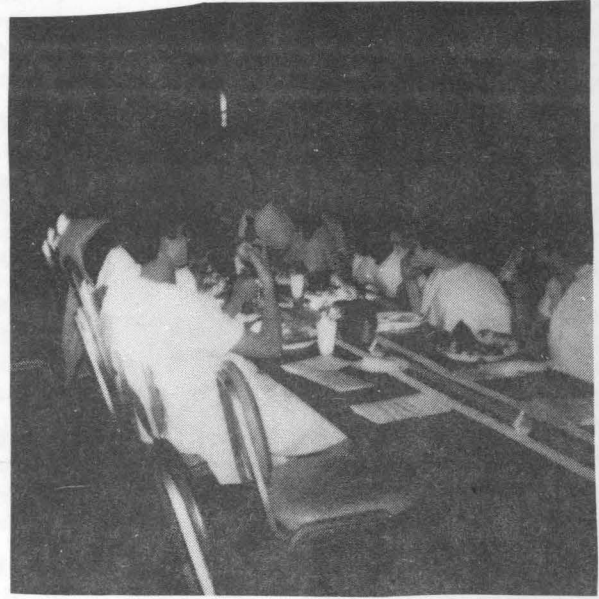
