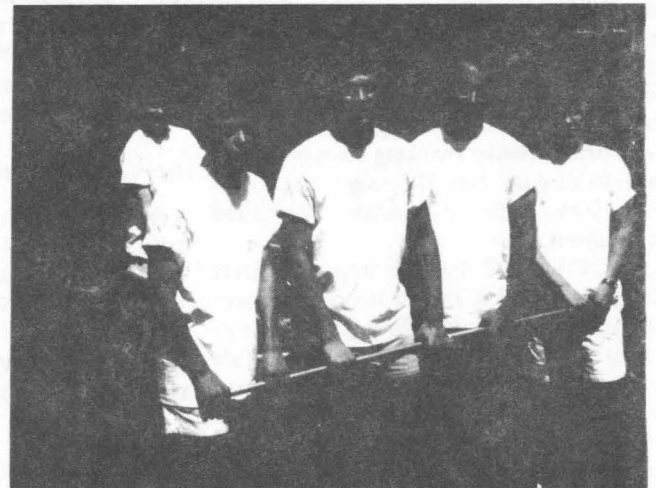
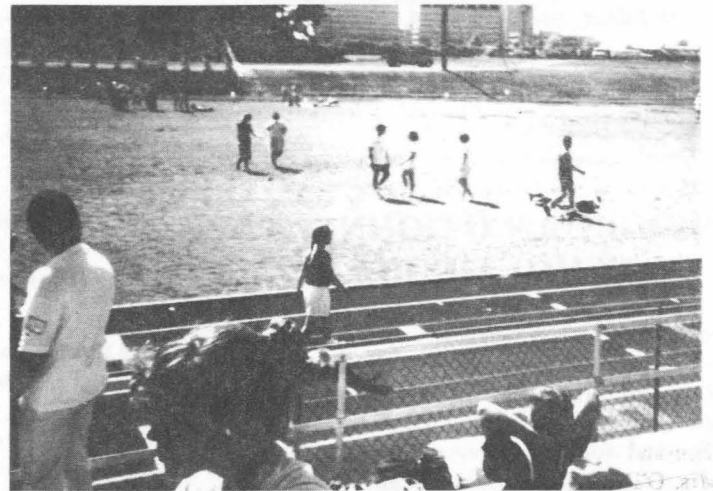


TJCL CONVENTION
