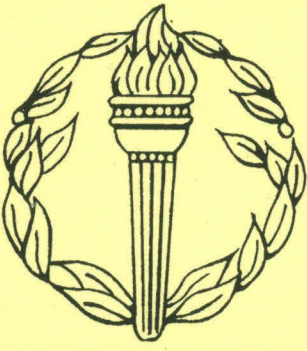

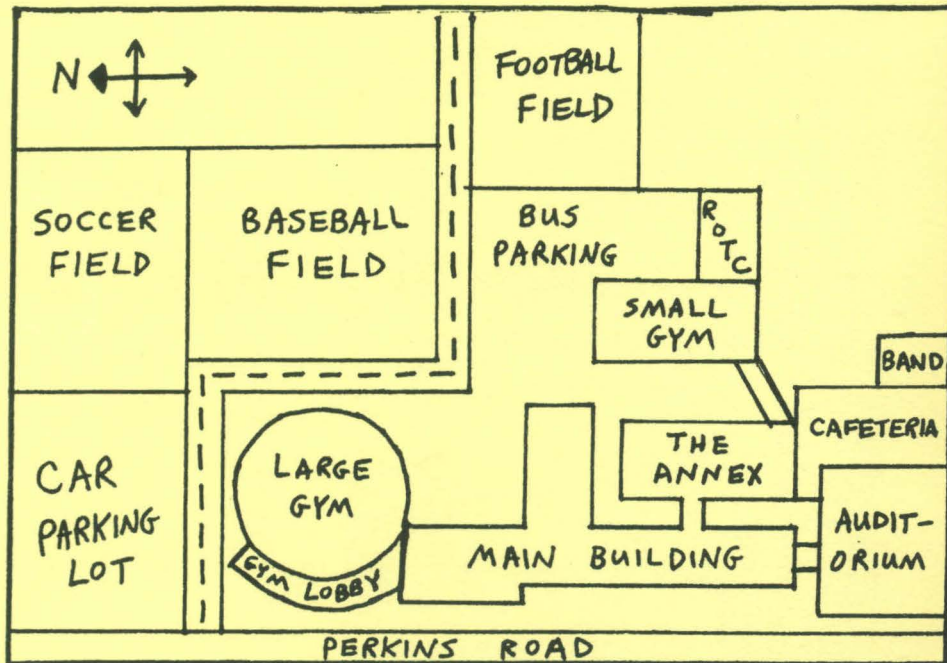

Some Conventional Wisdom

What is the Nominations Committee Meeting?

Each school is expected to send a delegate to this meeting at 9:00 a.m. on Friday so that the candidates for TJCL office may be selected. Each school that sends a delegate to this meeting and is in good standing shall receive two votes instead of one in the election.

What is the Spirit Contest?

It's a chance to yell, scream, and cheer for your school and for JCL. Wave signs, paint your faces, or shout cheers so that the judges will give you an award. Please DON'T cheer against other schools. How un-JCL that would be!

What do I do if I finish my tests early?

You could go watch (or participate in!) the Costume Contest, which always draws some very interesting costumes. Or you could see a movie (check the schedule for room number and time). Or you could participate in some friendly Ludi games (basketball and volleyball in the Large Gym, but be careful!). Or you could browse through TJCL Memory Lane in the Main Lobby outside the Library. Or you could simply wander around and meet people. After all, the motto of JCL is 'Amicitia' or 'Friendship'. Make some new friends and challenge them to a game of spades!

What are the Olympika?

The Olympika are competitive athletic events in swimming and track & field. They required preregistration on Friday morning, so if you didn't register then, you're too late. However, you can still watch the events if you have a ride to the Olympika location, which is the South Campus of the University of Memphis.

What is 'Certamen' and how is it pronounced?

Accent the middle syllable, and pronounce the 'c' as in 'cat'. Certamen (the Latin word for 'contest') is a fast-paced game involving recall of facts related to Latin and classical studies. Certamen also required preregistration but is nevertheless an exciting competition to watch. Certamen is like team Jeopardy without Alex Trebek.

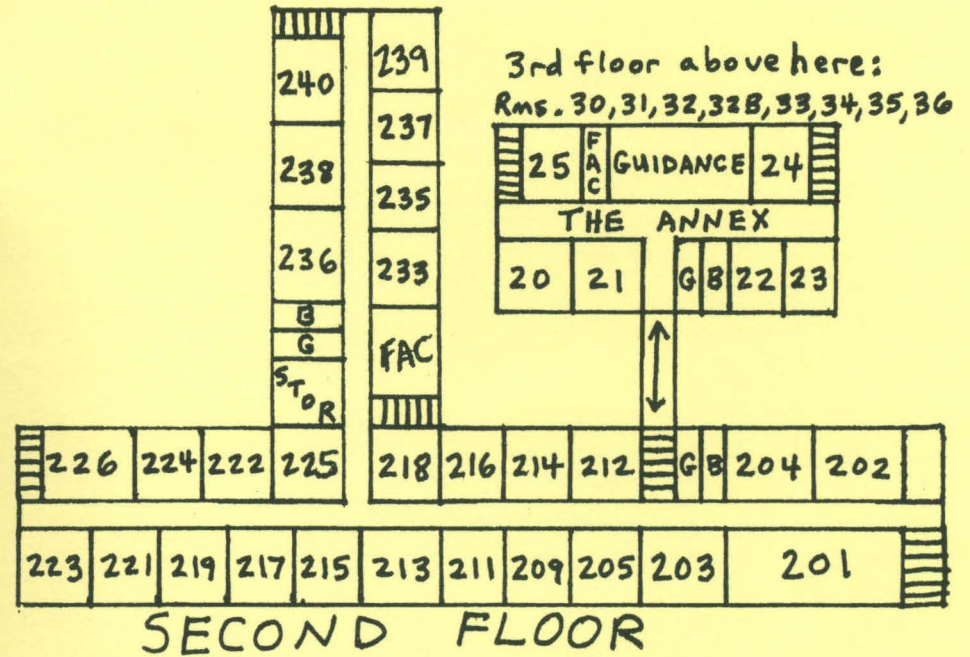
Do I have to wear a toga to the dance tonight?
