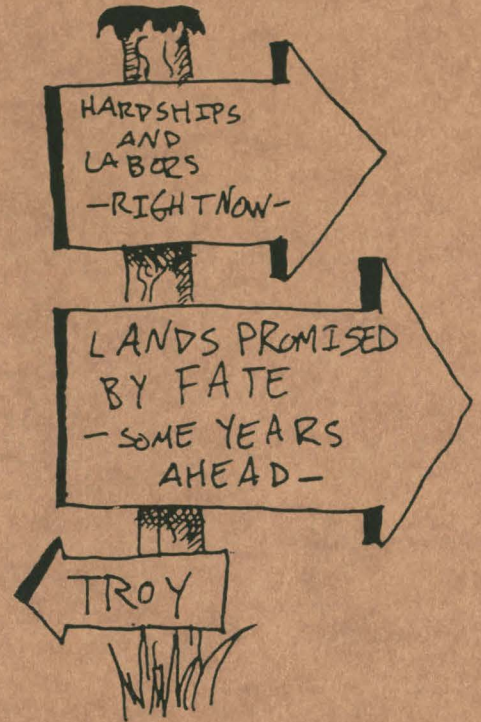

Some Conventional Wisdom

What is the Nominations Committee Meeting?

Each school is expected to send a delegate to this meeting at 3:00 on Friday so that the candidates for TJCL offices may be selected. Each school that sends a delegate to this meeting and is in good standing shall receive two votes instead of one in the election on Saturday.

What is the Candidates' Open Forum?

It's a chance to meet the candidates face-to-face and ask them about the ideas they have for TJCL. At least one delegate from each school is expected to attend, though more may attend if they wish.

What is 'Certamen' and how is it pronounced?

Accent the middle syllable, and pronounce the 'c' as in 'cat'. Certamen (the Latin word for 'contest') is a fast-paced game involving recall of facts related to Latin and classical studies. The Certamen competition had a required preregistration, but it is nevertheless an exciting competition for all to watch.

Do I have to wear a toga to the dance tonight?

Yes, you do! All JCLers must be in Roman-style attire during the Friday evening events. Please do remember to wear your name tag too, as it serves as your admission ticket to the dance. Roman costumes are a time-honored tradition at TJCL conventions.

Why are there so many events to choose from? I can't do them all!

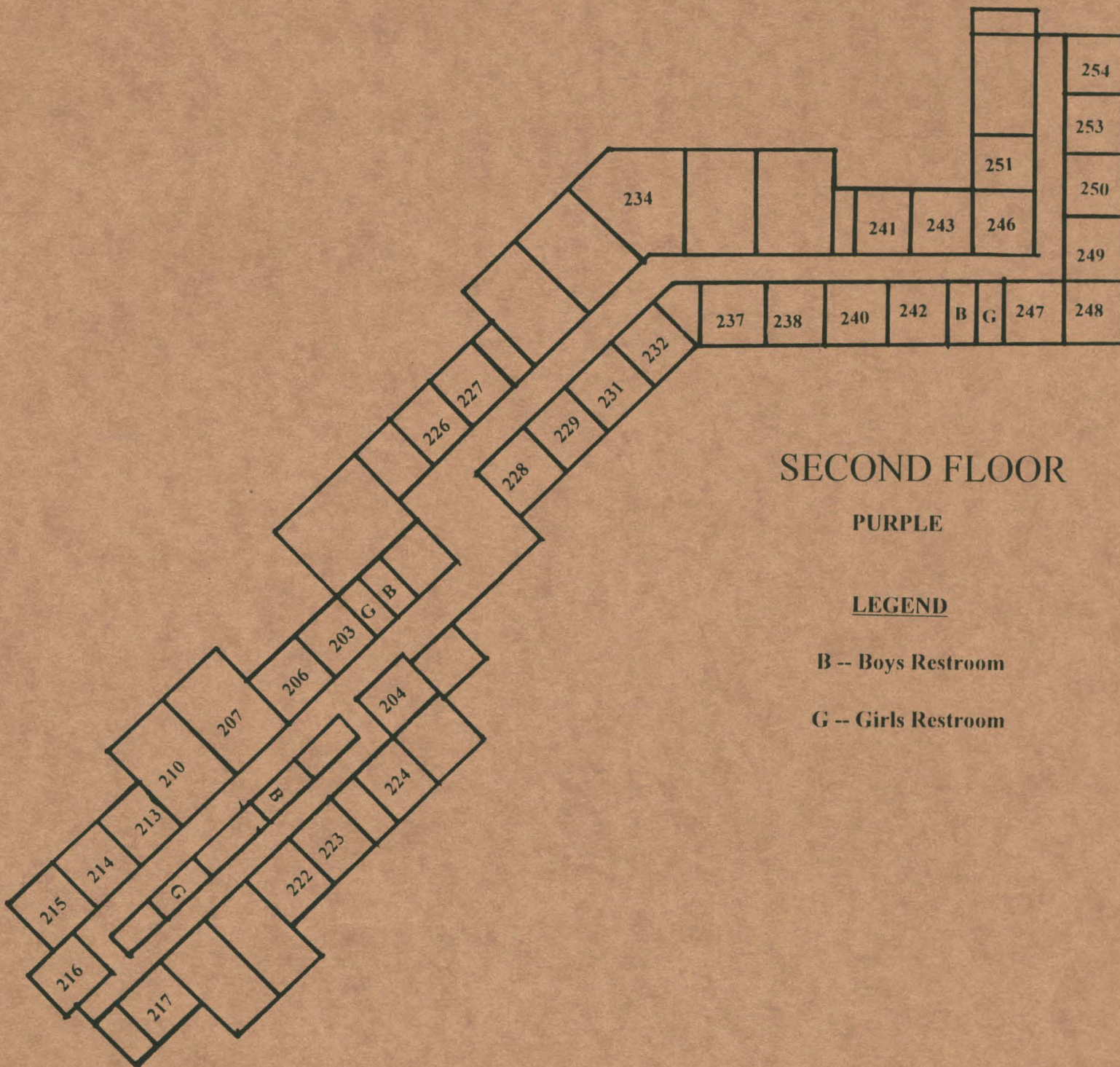

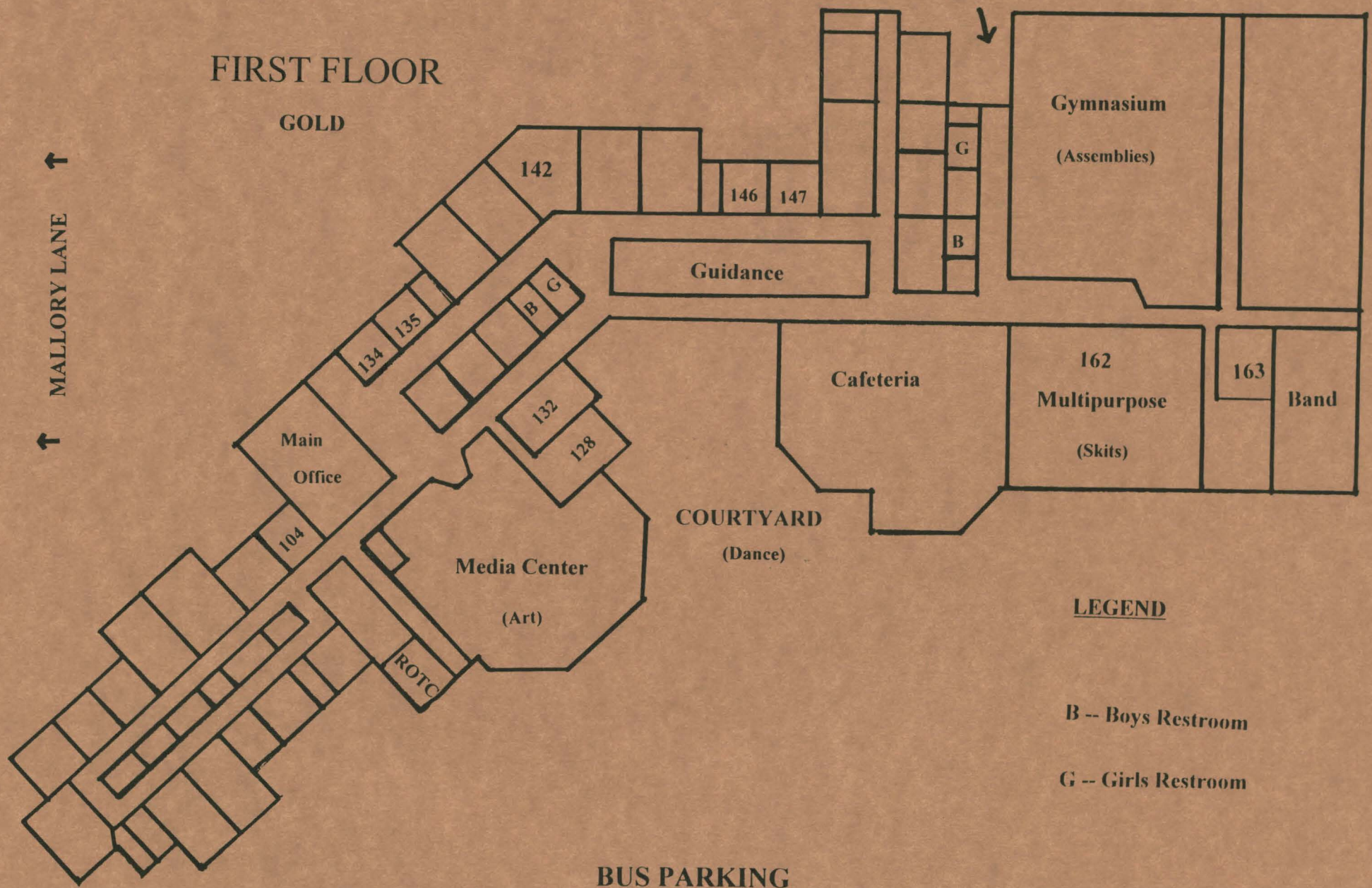
