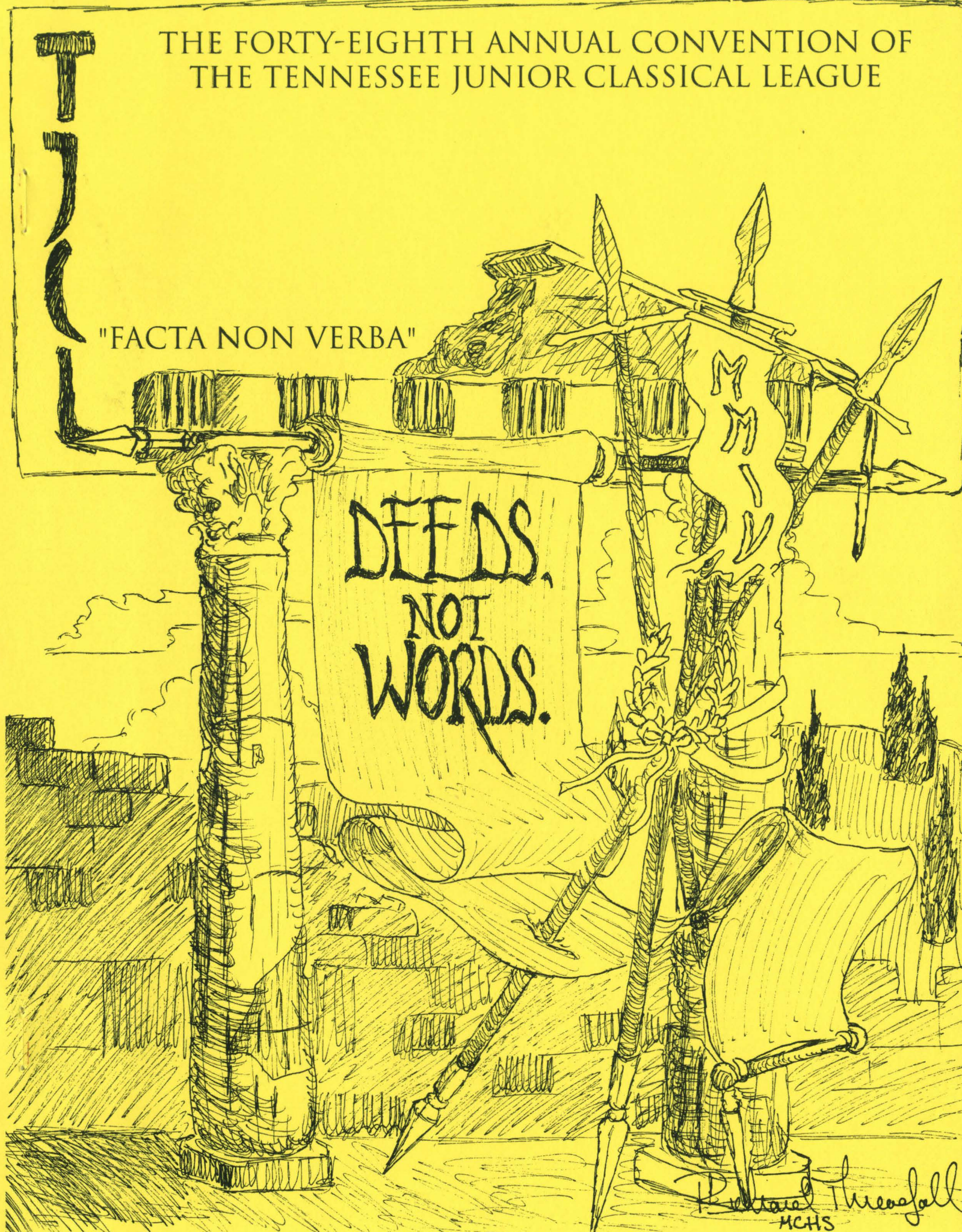

Short for Nomination Committee Meeting. Each school must send at least one delegate to this meeting, where TJCL's official ballot is formulated. The meeting is at 8:30 a.m. on Friday in the auditorium [directly across from the gym lobby's concession stand]. Each school present at this meeting and holding "good standing" status will receive two votes, instead of one, during Saturday's election.

Once again NJCL requires all national delegates to pay the full convention fee when requesting a packet. That fee is \$360. If you've never been to Nationals and would like to know more, multiply your experience at State Convention by 1000! That comes very close!

New and not so new @ Convention 2004:

SILLY CONTEST!!!!!!!: There will be 3 games setup in the field across from the main parking lot (paintball field). A **Bungee Run that is 32' Long, Moonwalk Set Up** (big trampoline), and a **Jousting Arena** (don't kill anyone). It costs \$1 per game, but it's well worth it!

Art Registration: You must stop at the appropriate registration table, complete the procedures, and then take your art to the library [*in the forbidden area of the building*].

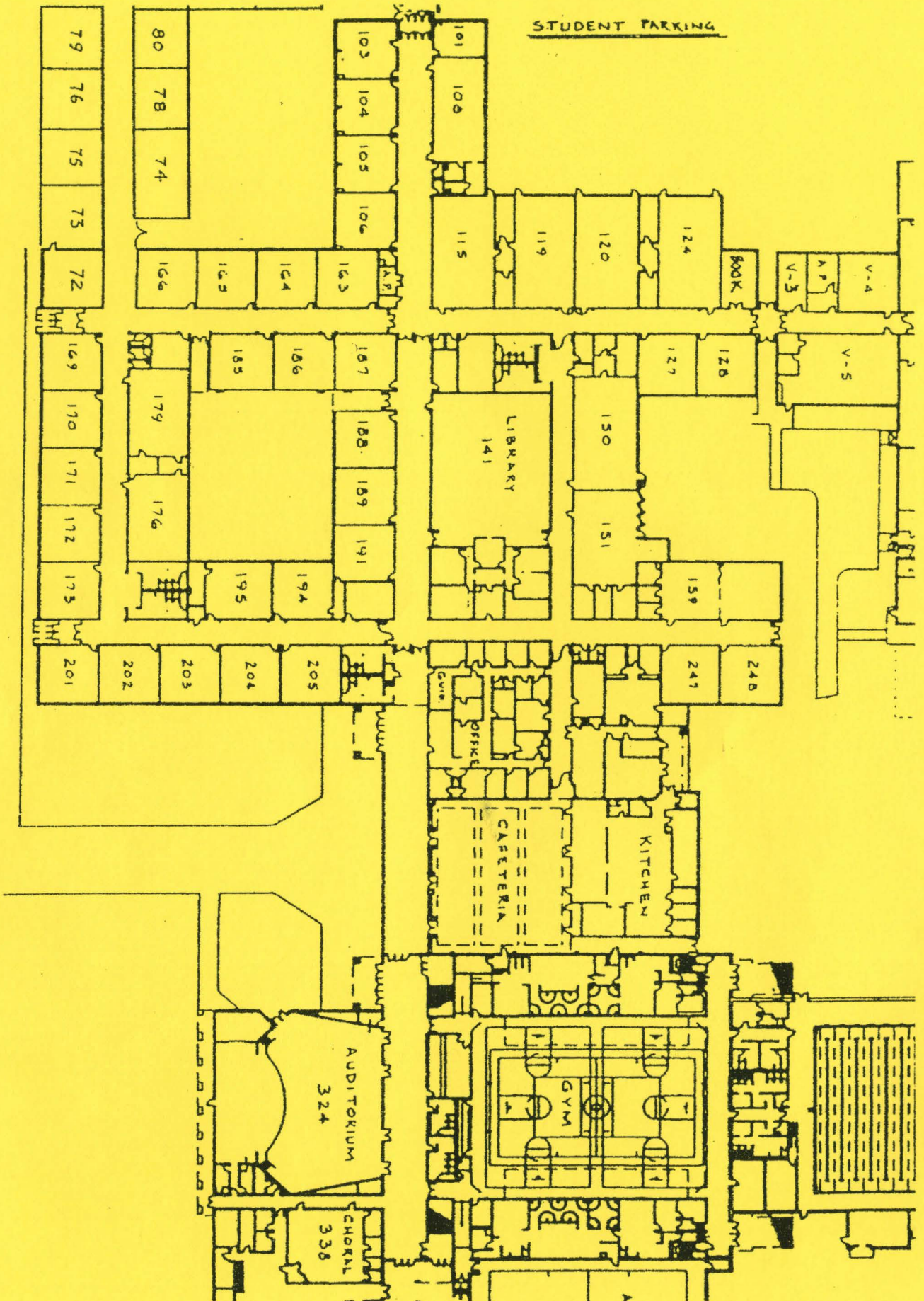
